SPECIAL MEETING OF THE TOWN COUNCIL

July 27, 2026

PUBLIC COMMENT: None

Attendance: Mayor Travis Page; Clerk-Treasurer Kellen Kirby; Council Members including Paul Heikkila, April Wells, Bob Williams and Becky Gorton; Council Members Michelle Stinson & Corbin Keaster were not present.

A special meeting of the town council was called to order by Mayor Travis Page who led the group in the saying of the Pledge of Allegiance. With no members of the public in presence of the meeting, Mayor Page spoke that the Town of Belt received an email from Cascade County Attorney's office. The email stated that the city was behind on payments of the Interlocal Agreement with the Cascade County Sheriff's Office. The payment that was due July 1, 2025, for \$36,549.40 and the same amount for January 1, 2026, was not received in total amount of \$73, 098.80. The current Interlocal Agreement is in effect until June 30, 2029. Council member Paul Heikkila motioned to pay the full amount under the current agreement, Becky Gorton seconded the motion. The motion carried with a unanimous vote. A check will be cut to Cascade County Sheriff's Department for \$73,098.80 and sent certified mail.

There being no further agenda business to attend to, Council member Paul Heikkila motioned to adjourn the meeting, Bob Williams seconded the motion. The meeting was adjourned at 6:12pm.
